1. Moisturises

 Epi-shield contains emollients including propylene glycol, cetyl acetate and oleyl acetate that moisturise your skin keeping it soft and supple.

2. Protects.

Usage Instructions.

 Apply small amount (pea size) to clean dry hands massage thoroughly into the skin.

 Repeat every 4 hours, or more frequently if required.

 Irritated hands are far more likely to harbour bacteria than hands that are in good condition.(4)

 *Applying Epi-shield on a regular basis will keep your hands in good condition.*(5)
